**TITLE:** Stevens Creek Trail Pedestrian/Bicycle Overcrossing at Moffett Boulevard, Project 04-33—Accept Construction

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Accept Stevens Creek Trail Pedestrian/Bicycle Overcrossing at Moffett Boulevard, Project 04-33, and authorize the final contract payment.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

Stevens Creek Trail Pedestrian/Bicycle Overcrossing at Moffett Boulevard, Project 04-33, is funded with \$4,900,000 from the Shoreline Community Fund. The final construction cost of \$3,114,143 is within the construction budget of \$3,362,940. The total project expenditure is approximately \$4,700,000. The remaining balance of approximately \$200,000 will be returned to the Shoreline Community Fund.

### **BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS**

On April 22, 2008, the City Council awarded the construction contract for Stevens Creek Trail Pedestrian/Bicycle Overcrossing at Moffett Boulevard, Project 04-33, to Jones Brothers Enterprises, Inc., of Morgan Hill, California, at the low bid price of \$3,362,940, which included a \$350,000 construction contingency.

The project included a 479' long prefabricated truss bridge with a concrete deck, 750' of retaining walls and 4,800' of driven concrete piles. The bridge construction, fabrication and welding was inspected and approved by Caltrans. The project eliminated the last at-grade road crossing along Stevens Creek Trail, and was opened and dedicated on June 13, 2009.

The final construction cost of \$3,114,143 included eight change orders totaling \$101,203 for traffic control, asphalt paving, concrete barrier, drainage, electrical and irrigation and planting revisions. All work has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

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


