Please be advised that construction activities for the new Stevens Creek Trail Pedestrian Bridge are scheduled to begin in early February 2011. It is anticipated that this work will be completed by March 2012, weather permitting. Normal construction hours will be from 7:30am-4:00pm, Monday through Friday. During construction the existing trail will remain open for public use.

One of the first items of work includes installation of a temporary construction road adjacent to the existing trail to allow equipment and construction crews to safely access the work area from Route 85 on-ramp from eastbound El Camino Real. Portion of the existing trail between the two PG&E towers will be temporarily detoured to accommodate the temporary road. During the temporary road the existing trail will remain open at all time with minor traffic control for the trail user's safety. This work is scheduled to begin February 7th, 2011.

Construction of the bridge foundations will soon follow and includes both Steel Tubular Piles in the freeway median and west side of Rte 85; and Drilled holes filled with reinforced concrete at Dale/Heatherstone side. The installation of the steel pipe piles typically produces considerable noise and varies in intensity based on the proximity to the work. It is anticipated that the pile installation, both steel tubular piles and drilled holes, will begin February 14th and 21st, respectively, lasting for approximately 3 weeks.

Traffic control measures will be implemented at Dale Avenue and Heatherstone Way and a separate notice will be released in advance for freeway closures required to construct the bridge over Route 85.

We appreciate your patience and look forward to working with the City of Mountain View on this project. It is our pleasure to provide this great community with a beautiful and useful structure such as the one that will be constructed.
