Noticeable noise and vibration may occur.

Where: Pile driving activity will occur in the vicinity of southbound U.S. 101

between Terra Bella and Linda Vista Avenues. Traffic will

not be affected.

Project Status:

Crews will move the crane from the gore area at the Route 85/U.S. 101 Interchange on the evening of Friday, July 11 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. the following morning.

Once the crane is moved, crews will begin to drive piles in three locations along southbound U.S. 101 between Terra Bella and Linda Vista Avenues for the construction of bridge columns to support the new Shoreline Boulevard braided ramp. Crews will then form and pour footings and columns.
